Organisers retain the right to remove anyone who violates these principles from the workshop.

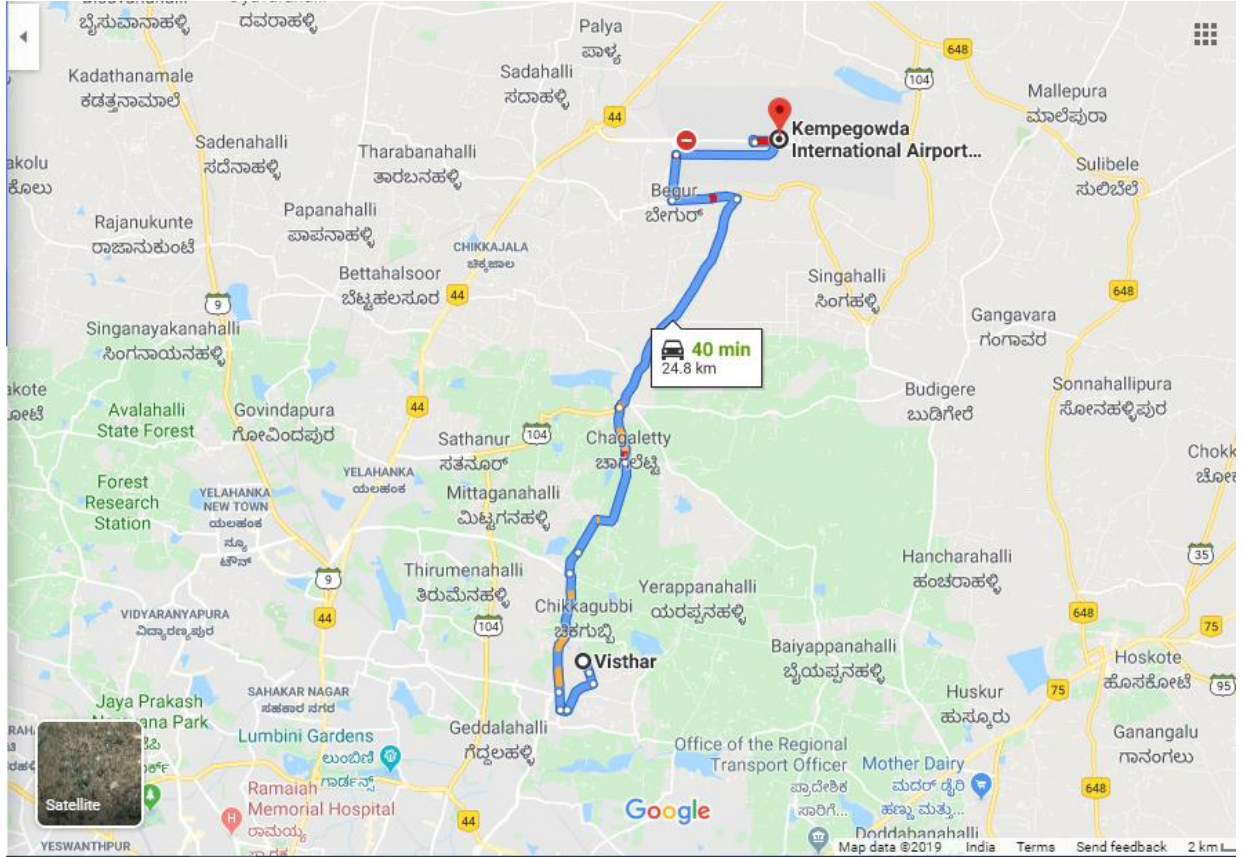
